

We are looking for a mechanic to join our team that can service, inspect, diagnose issues, assemble, repair, and install parts and accessories to UTVs.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Perform maintenance and/or repair on UTVs
- Installs wire harnesses and components in UTVs, drills into roll cage and fish wire through.
- Operates tools and equipment.
- Mounts tires on to bead lock and non-bead lock wheels.
- Install cages, doors, seats, etc.
- Order and track parts/accessories for jobs.
- Locates malfunctions and determines type and amount of rework required to repair.
- Prepares packages for harness fabrication by cutting, labeling, and kitting.
- Tests wire harnesses, and UTV electrical systems for continuity and proper functioning.
- Follows schematics, drawings, and written or verbal instructions to set up and perform duties.
- Completes paperwork, hard copy and electronic version, associated with job assignment.
- Inspect and evaluate materials, components, assemblies, tools and product configuration to ensure quality assurance.
- Follow all safety procedures and reports unsafe conditions to management.
- Reports job status and restraints to coworkers and management.
- Identifies production inefficiencies and suggests potential improvements to product or process.
- Answer phone in a timely manner and greet customers.
- Clean and organize shop, maintain a safe workplace.

- Ability to lift 50+ pounds
